During the 2015 - 2016 Lodge year, the Elks of Iowa donated \$65,681.85 to the

Elks National Foundation!

This year, the Foundation will give back the following:

State Charities Grant: \$45,060.00 Special Projects Grant: \$35,280.00

Grand Total: \$127,570.00

For the 2015 – 2016 fiscal year (so far...), for example, we were awarded a total of \$74,500.00 to 18 Iowa Lodges!


