On 11-11 I received a communication from the blind company that due an unforeseen issue that they wouldn't be fulfilling anymore blind orders for the rest for the 2016 year and will not be taking any orders for the 2017 year.

I discussed our predicament with a couple lodge members and we agreed to wait and do a special presentation once at our lodge to the WWIAF board once the blind has arrived.
