The 2016-2017 Elks year has ended and the numbers are in. Our Lodge donated \$ 3742.00 or \$ 11.91 per member to the ENF this year. we finished 4th in the State. Burlington Lodge #84 finished first with \$25.62 per member. All 30 lodges in the State donated this year with 29 of the 30 making the GER goal of 4.65 per member! the State of Iowa exceeded it's goal and finished at \$ 6.96 per member!. Nationally it appears that we will finish the year at \$ 8.15 per member. The Shenandoah lodge received back from the ENF \$7,000 in Grant money to be used to better our communities.
